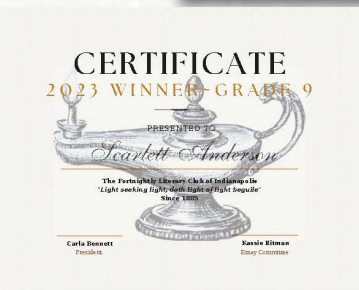

This annual essay contest began in 2006, and was spearheaded by Peggy Sabens, with the assistance of Ann Cummins and a small committee, working with the English Department of Herron High School.
